STATE UPDATE

- **Student Success Update:** If the state budget goes the way we expect, we should be able to implement a number of Student Success improvements. If we are successful in protecting the Governor's 2014-15 budget proposal, this would mark the first time in recent memory that the state continued investing in a legislative priority beyond the first year.
- **Community College Baccalaureate:** Senator Block has modified SB850 which would authorize a pilot of the community college Baccalaureate in California. The revised language limits the pilot to 20 districts and no more than one degree at any college. It also puts most of the decision-making responsibility in the hands of the Board of Governors (BOG). Support is encouraging but there are still hurdles.
- **"LaunchBoard" Rollout:** A workshop overviewing LaunchBoard was well received at the recent CIO Conference when they saw its value as a resource for accreditation preparation and program review. LaunchBoard is a tool for practitioners in our colleges and our partners to make data-backed decisions on CTE/workforce outcomes.
- **Summary of Accreditation:** The percentage of the Community Colleges state-wide currently on sanction has been cut in half since last July. As of mid-February, there were ten colleges (including IVC) on Warning and one on Probation. No colleges were on Show Cause. One (Community College of San Francisco) is facing termination of accreditation.
