



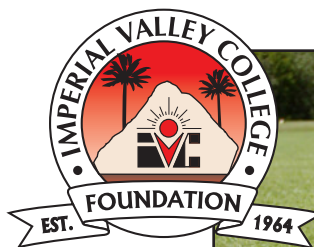

## State Update

Governor Brown has signed the following 2015 Community College-related legislative measures:

- **AB288 (Holden) College and Career Act:** Provides a voluntary framework to offer dual enrollment for CTE, transfer, improving graduation rates, or college and career readiness.
- **AB 653 (Levine) Community College Contracting Practices:** Permits community colleges to make purchases of materials, equipment, or services through existing California State University or University of California contracts.
- **AB 798 (Bonilla) Community College Textbook Affordability Act:** Lowers textbook expenses for students by creating incentives for campuses to use Open Educational Resources.
- **AB 767 (Santiago) Community Colleges Preparedness Standards:**

Requires that the Chancellor's Office review and update its emergency preparedness standards by January 1, 2017.

- **SB 186 (Jackson) College Districts Removal, Suspension, Expulsion:** Authorizes governing boards to remove, suspend, or expel a student for sexual assault or sexual exploitation, regardless of the victim's affiliation with the college, even if the offense is not related to college activity or attendance.
- **AB 963 (Bonilla) Teachers Retirement Law:** Permits current members in CalSTRS to be "grandfathered" into the system, removing concerns that they may be expelled from their retirement system in the future and clarifies the Education Code regarding placement of educational administrators in either CalSTRS or CalPERS.
