

STATE UPDATE

- State Budget: The flexibility the Governor recommended in the \$125 million State Budget increase to our base allocation may not stand in the Legislature. Lawmakers are likely to want to be more specific in how those funds are allocated.
- Student Success and Equity Investments: In late January, the State of the System Report was released and the news was good. Our total awards, transfer, course completions and basic skills in math, English and ESL numbers are all moving upward, but slowly.
