

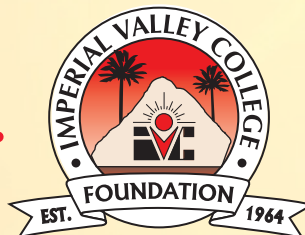

safeTALK about three hours in duration, is a training that prepares anyone over the age of 15 to identify persons with thoughts of suicide and connect them to suicide first aid resources. Most people with thoughts of suicide invited help to stay safe. Alert helpers know how to use these opportunities to support that desire for safety. As a safeTALK-trained suicide alert helper, you will be better able to:

- move beyond common tendencies to miss, dismiss or avoid suicide;
- identify people who have thoughts of suicide;
- apply the TALK steps (Tell, Ask, Listen and Keep Safe) to connect a person with suicide thoughts to suicide first aid, intervention caregivers.

## STATE UPDATE

- **AB 288:** The Legislature unanimously has passed Assembly Bill 288 (Holden), the College & Career Access Pathways (CCAP) Act. AB 288 is the vehicle for long overdue reforms to California's dual/concurrent enrollment laws. This has been a high priority for our system, the League, and the Board of Governors. It is now on the Governor's desk.
- **Accreditation Task Force Report:** The report is brief and to the point. Regional accreditation is extremely important to all of us and to the public, but the report states our current accreditation system is not working. The report and appendices are at this website: <http://californiacommunity-colleges.cccco.edu/Portals/O/reports/2015-Accreditation-Report-ADA.pdf>
- **Workforce Task Force:** Later this month the report will be presented to the Board of Governors. The entire report can be found by selecting Doing What Matters at [www.cccco.edu](http://www.cccco.edu).
- **edu.** It is likely to have the same impact on our system related to career technical education that the Student Success Task Force report had on our system in recent years.
- **Student Success and Support Program and Student Equity Program:** Final drafts of the Student Success and Support Program and the Student Equity Plan templates are being prepared to disseminate to colleges. It is important to note that both programs received significant increases to their appropriation for the current fiscal year (\$200,000,000 for SSSP and \$155,000,000 for SEP).
- **2015-16 Noncredit SSSP Funding Update:** The 2015-16 Noncredit Student Success and Support (SSSP) advance totaling \$8,898,438 was sent to the colleges in July. The amount of the advance is based on 95 percent of the 2014-15 allocation for the 67 noncredit programs. The plans are due to the CCCCO by October 30, 2015.
