Registered Nursing – New Process

- The Dept. of Consumer Affairs (DCA) and the Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) has implemented a new process program for graduates seeking licenser as a RN.
- This requires changes to a several operational areas at IVC
 - RN program submits preliminary and final graduate roster.
 - Registrar Office uploads electronic transcripts to the BRN Cloud
 - Information Technology assists the Registrar with the technical side of the forms/format and ensuring information protection
 - Students complete online application process

Admissions & Records Update


- Live with Credentials Inc. is our new transcript vendor! 330 transcripts have been processed by Credentials, Inc., since October 7th.
