

The legislative session has barely begun and already there are a number of bills impacting community colleges:

- 1. SB15 (Leyva) would set the maximum amount for annual Cal Grant C awards for tuition and fees at \$2,462, and for Cal Grant C awards access costs at \$3,000.
- 2. SB 25 (Portantino) would require the Legislative Analyst's Office to assess and make recommendations regarding the complete integration of the state's schools and the California Community Colleges into one coordinated education system.
- 3. AB 19 (Santiago) would lower the amount of unmet financial need a student needs to demonstrate to qualify for a Board of Governors fee waiver to at least \$1.
- 4. AB 21 (Kalra) would set requirements of community college boards to protect their students from deportation, provide them access to legal services, and provide them stipends for health care and housing between academic terms.
- 5. AB 52 would require all public employers (including community colleges) to provide all employees with an orientation, while permitting the exclusive representative of those employees to participate in the orientation.
