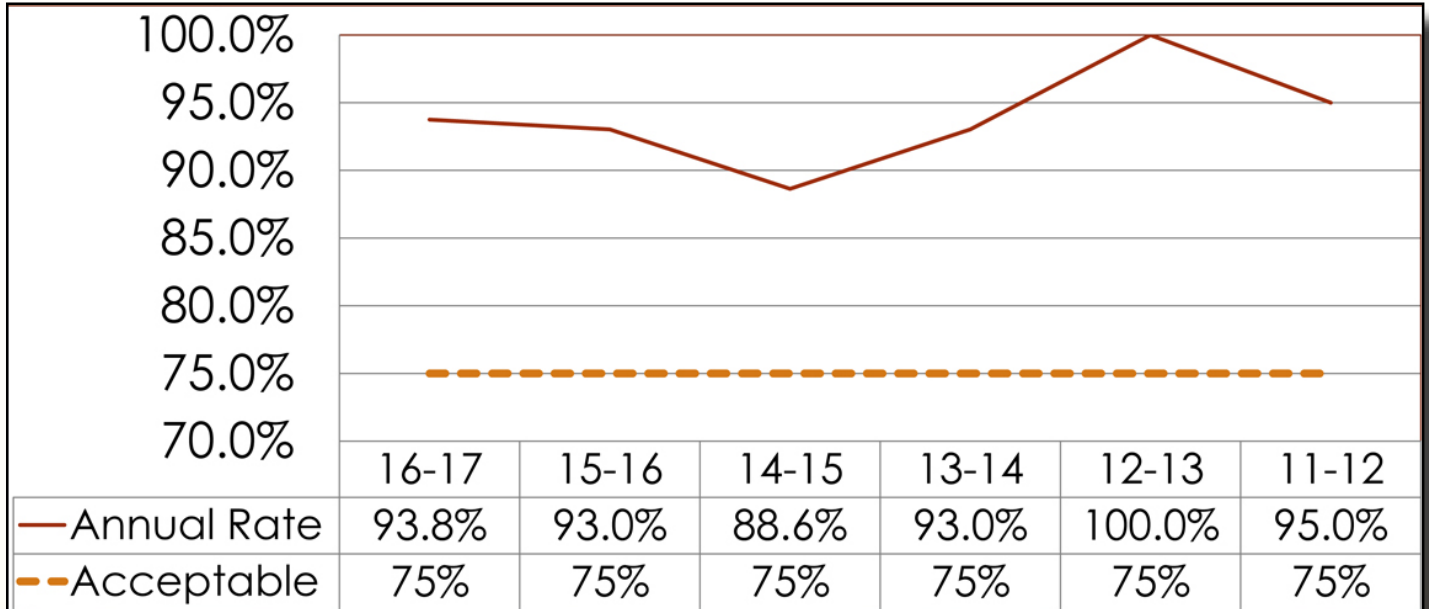

## INSTRUCTOR RECOGNITION

- Carlos Ramirez, a part-time instructor, was invited to an event at the University of Delaware by the Vice Provost for Diversity. Carlos teaches part-time in the RN program and is the Executive Director for our local Accent Home Health.

## STUDENT SERVICES - Financial Aid

- Financial Aid staff will be participating in Higher Ed Week II at our local high schools next week
- Summer Financial Aid awards have been posted for over 3,000 eligible students
- The 2017-18 awarding process will begin this week.
- 2017-18 Financial Aid applications are up 22.5% over this time last year. We have received 6,225 FAFSA files to date.

## STUDENT SERVICES -Admissions & Records Office

- 534 students participating in Commencement 2017. The largest so far!
- Of the 534 graduates participating in Commencement, 221 are graduating with Honors and 74 with Distinction.
- Of the 534 graduates participating in Commencement, 57% have earned a 3.0 or better.
- 1,092 students have applied for Spring 2017 degrees of which 329 are ADT's (Degrees for Transfer). This is a 21% increase from last year.
- Top 3 majors are: AJ for Transfer, General Science and Psychology for Transfer.
- Summer 2017 Priority Enrollment began Monday, May 15. Our FTES target for Summer is 450.

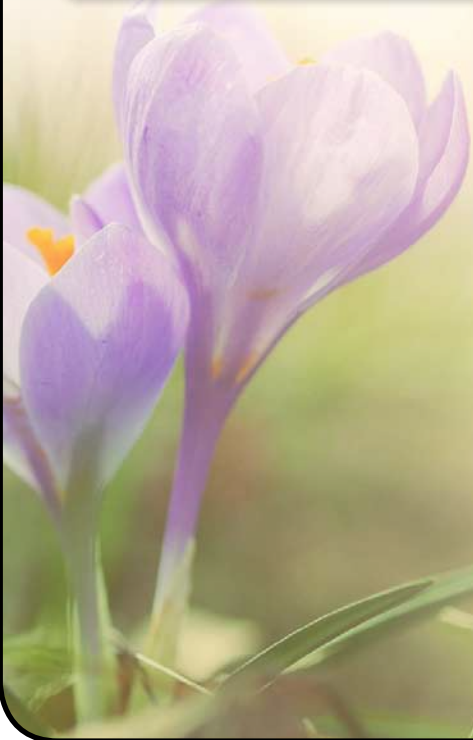


## STUDENT SERVICES – Upward Bound

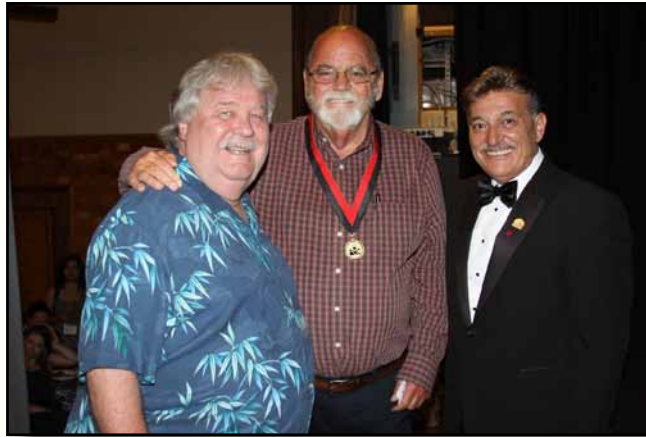

## STATE UPDATE – May Revise

- Contains an additional \$160 million of base increase for a total of \$183.6 million due to cost increases in areas such as pension rates, employee benefits, and utilities.
- This brings the total provided for a base increase to \$552.3 million over the three-year period.
- Growth reduction from 1.34% to 1%.
- In this budget, the Governor proposed a higher investment in schools and colleges than is required by the constitutional minimum funding level. This forces education to compete with other state General Fund cost pressures.
- Unknown whether the Legislature will concur with funding K-14 above the guaranteed Proposition 98 minimum.
- Stay tuned.
