

STATE UPDATE

Community College Bachelor's Degree:

The Assembly Committee on Higher Education has voted 12-1 to approve SB 769, which will now move forward to the Assembly Appropriations Committee. The bill, as amended, adds another 5 years to the sunset date, thereby stabilizing the existing pilot programs for the present time. If the Appropriations Committee approves the bill and the Governor signs it, the new law will usher in this important improvement. Next will be the Logislative



in this important improvement. Next will be the Legislative Analyst's Office report on the pilot program and, in January, Senator Jerry Hill plans to introduce a new bill in the hope of expanding the pilot so that more colleges can participate and more students and communities can benefit.
