#### PRESIDENT'S OFFICE

- The Legislature approved a balanced budget, which includes \$1 million for Imperial Valley College's Medical Assistant Program and Correctional Academy Program.
- Assembly member Garcia worked with Imperial Valley College to advocate for this investment.
- Dr. Martha Garcia submitted a proposal that will enable IVC to create a correctional academy that will follow the guidelines and policies set forth by the Board of State and Community Corrections (STC) for the State of California and will provide the college the opportunity to offer a full-time Medical Assistant Program.

## **ACADEMIC SERVICES**

- → Registered Nursing Associate Degree
  - 21 students completed all four semesters
  - Six students are men a higher rate than most of the state
  - 93.3% is the NCLEX Pass Rate for the first three quarters of 2017-18
  - 107 Students will be in enrolled in the RN Program in Fall 2018

#### **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

#### **State: Athletic Programs**

- The Senate Education Committee will hear AB 1435 (Gonzalez Fletcher) later this month.
- It puts at risk many of the collegiate athletic programs at higher education institutions, including California's community colleges.
- Would create a new one-size-fits-all bureaucracy with significant regulatory powers over collegiate athletics.
- Would create a panel that could craft regulations for all collegiate athletics and have significant oversight powers that are duplicative of the functions of the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) or the United States Department of Education.
- We have sent a letter to the committee outlining our concerns.

## **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

#### **Federal: Prosper Act**

The U.S. House of Representatives is expected to act later this month on HR 4508, the PROSPER Act, to reauthorize the Higher Education Act. HR 4508 includes a number of concerning provisions that would harm our colleges and the students we serve:

- Substantial Increase Liability for Unearned Title IV Funds
- Elimination of Title III-A: Strengthening Institutions Program
- Reduction of Financial Aid Resources for Students

#### **Federal: DACA**

House Republicans will vote on two immigration bills that include provisions for Dreamers.
