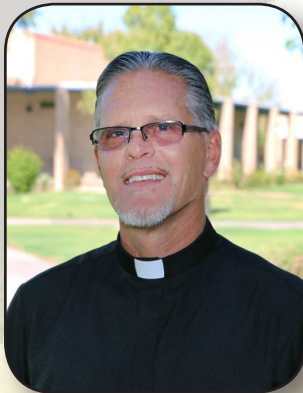

Allied Health and Nursing

- Nursing 80 course provides orientation to our new incoming RN students. The course ran from June 18 to June 29. All 30 students completed the course successfully!

ACADEMIC SERVICES

Fire Technology/Fire Academy

- Our State Fire Accreditation was renewed for an additional five years. Currently, there are only 38 Accredited Regional Training Programs (ARTP's) in the State of California. We became the 33rd ARTP in 2013.
- Since the inception of the fire academy in 2003, a total of **98** IVC fire academy graduates have attained a job at a local fire department within the County.
- Three of the six core classes have been converted into a Distance Education (DE) format. The three remaining core classes are being converted to DE format.

➤ AB 705 Update

In July, Dr. Cynthia Spence, Assistant Professor of English, became a certificated trainer with the California Acceleration Project (CAP).

As a trainer, Dr. Spence will:

 - Two sections of ENGL 55 are being piloted Fall 2018 as concurrent support for ENGL 110.

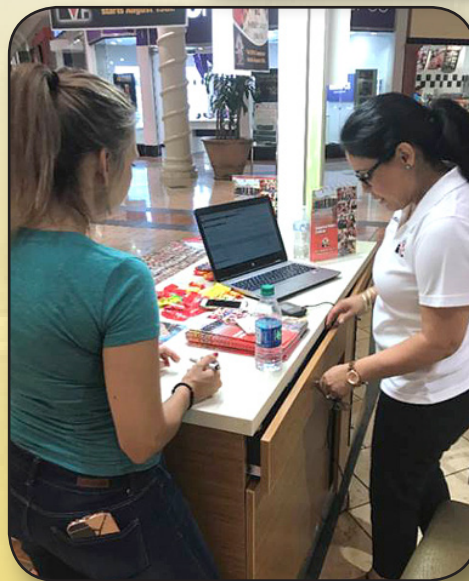

STUDENT SERVICES

Financial Aid

- **2017-18 FA:** Total funds disbursed \$35.2 million, this reflects a 19% increase in comparison to 2016-17.
- **2018-19 FA:** We have disbursed \$1.5 million to students for the initial Fall payment.
- **Campus Logic:** This is the system that will enable students to electronically complete verification online and is scheduled to go live September 4th.
