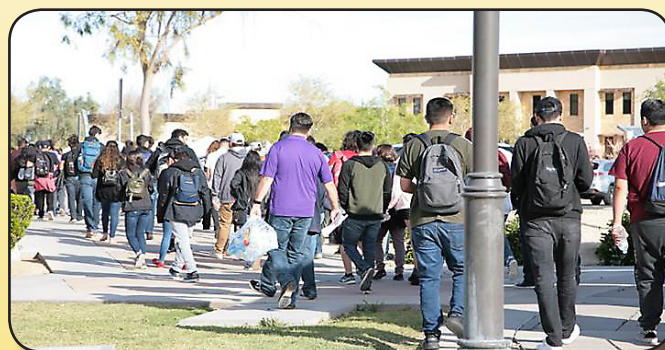
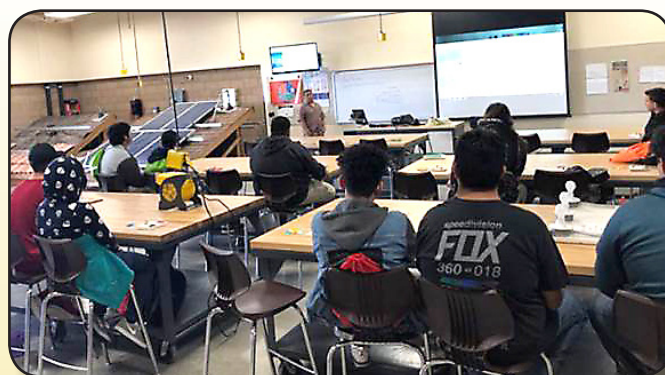
## ACADEMIC SERVICES

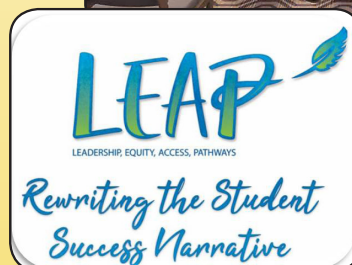

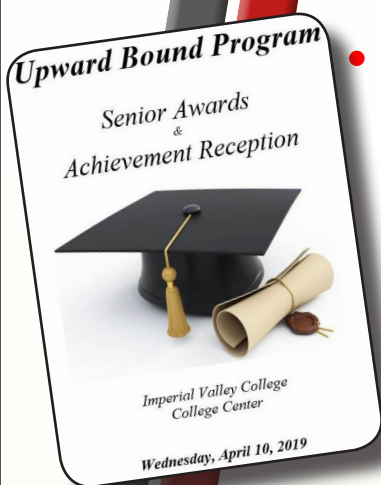
