- Replace all exterior doors at Gym

- Replace men's baseball field scoreboard
- Install LED Lighting in buildings 400, 900, 2700, 3100, & 3200

- Crack fill/resurface all parking lots and perimeter roads

ACADEMIC SERVICES


- On July 30th, students from IVC Talent Search and local high schools participated in a three-hour robot building and programming challenge.

Admissions & Records

- Spring 2019 Graduation Evaluations are complete.
 - 2,255 graduation applications were evaluated, (1,912 were awarded Spring 2019).
 - > 1,472 applications for degrees, (1,235 were awarded).
 - > (944 were awarded Spring 2018)
 - > 783 applications for certificates, (677 were awarded Spring 2019).
 - > (532 were awarded Spring 2018)
- Summer 2019 Graduation Evaluations will be completed next month.

Financial Aid

- Fall Semester \$1.8 million was paid out to 3000 students last week.
- The Financial Aid Office will be participating in Higher Ed Week I at local high schools from September 23-26, 2019.
- IVC in collaboration with Imperial County Office of Education will be hosting a California Student Aid Commission High School Counselor Workshop on October 9, 2019. Our local High School counselors and Higher Education Professionals usually travel to San Diego or the Inland Empire to attend these type of workshops. This is a great opportunity.









