 - This is a collaborative partnership to facilitate transfers from Imperial Valley College to the University of Arizona-Yuma.




ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

Business Services participated in the **ASG Welcome Back** event to connect with students and inform them of the services offered. Students had an opportunity to win a Starbucks Gift Card.




ACADEMIC SERVICES

- Summer Graduation Evaluations are complete
 - 350 graduation applications were awarded.
 - 234 degrees were awarded.
 (167 were awarded Summer 2018)
 - 116 certificates were awarded.
 (88 were awarded Summer 2018)


