
ACADEMIC SERVICES








2020-2021 BUDGET UPDATE

- The state will develop a "workload budget", which means it will reflect a 2019-2020 baseline budget, no new budget proposals will be considered by the legislature.
- Legislature priorities are as follows: COVID-19 related expenditures, wildfire prevention and homelessness.
- We should anticipate changes and a budget reduction.
- The budget will be passed on June 15th; however, it is expected to be revised.
 We should expect an August revision versus a May revision.
