- Convocation speaker Reggie Dabbs was amazing and so inspirational.



Alternate Care Site Impact

- As of August 17th, 213 community members were treated at the alternate care site with an average length of stay of 4.48 days (approximately 955 hospital bed-days total).
- This service enabled our local hospitals to focus resources on the most severely ill COVID-19 patients, and undoubtedly has saved lives.
