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



The Student Equity & Achievement Program is home to the IVC Kitchen, and we recently had an outpour of support from IVC employees to make a difference in the lives of our most vulnerable students. On December 10th, our Basic Needs Team and several IVC employee volunteers came together to make the holidays special for our students.

172 students attended our Basic Needs Distribution last week to pick up enough food to feed themselves and586 family members, for a total of 758 people served.
