

ACADEMIC SERVICES

➤ Career Technical Education Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) is a statewide study to assess employment outcomes of students who have participated in career technical education coursework.

For 2020, program completers from IVC reported:

- 66.7% obtained employment within 0-3 months and 61.1% are employed full-time
 - 63.8% have a job that is closely related to their field of study
 - 88.1% are satisfied/very satisfied with their education/training at IVC
 - Median earnings increased by over \$7/hour
 - Median earnings for non-transfer students increased to \$23/hour


