


Guided Pathways Student Success Teams, staff and administrators participated in Starfish training on June 8, 2021.

- In the Spring 2021 Semester, 14 students graduated from the Registered Nursing Program.
- 12 of the students have secured employment at Pioneers Memorial Health District in Brawley.
- 1 student has secured employment at El Centro Regional Medical Center.



The POST Level I Academy graduated 18 cadets on June 10, 2021.

Three graduates have already secured employment as police officers.

- Two with El Centro PD
- One with Calexico PD

STATE UPDATE (BUDGET)

- In June, the Assembly and Senate passed AB 128, a bicameral state budget deal for the 2021-22 fiscal year. Unlike prior years, the Senate and Assembly budget bill does not reflect a final agreement with the Governor. In the following week and a half the Senate, Assembly, and Governor will continue negotiations on a final 2021-22 state spending plan.
- Governor Newsom is expected to reach an agreement with the Senate and Assembly before the end of the month in time for the start of the new fiscal year on July 1, 2021.
- Once an agreement is reached, the Senate and Assembly anticipate amending the 2021 Budget Act to reflect changes included in the final deal between the Legislature and the Administration. Budget implementation language will follow in the weeks after an agreement is approved through a series of trailer bills.
