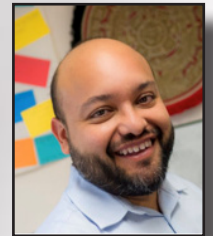

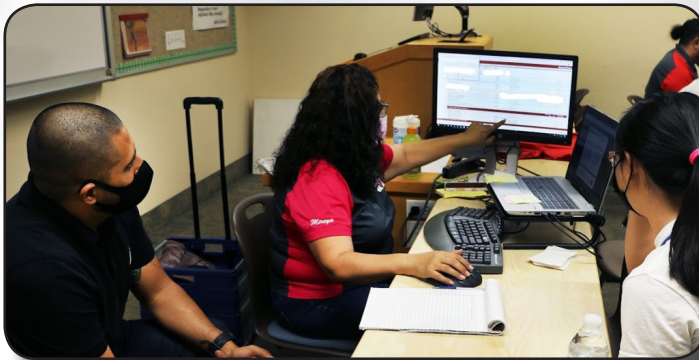

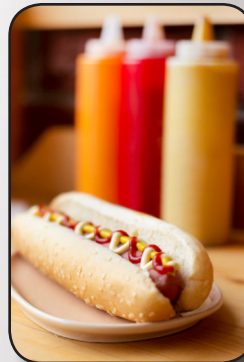

STATE UPDATE

- California Community Colleges Chancellor Eloy Ortiz Oakley will join the Biden administration in a temporary role to provide advice on higher education policy, and Deputy Chancellor Daisy Gonzales will serve as acting chancellor until his return in the late fall, Board of Governors President Pamela Haynes announced Monday.
- Oakley's new assignment starts July 26 at which time **Deputy Chancellor Daisy Gonzales, PhD.**, will serve as acting chancellor of the California Community Colleges, overseeing policy, fiscal and advocacy matters for the 116-college system that serves 2.1 million students.
