

STUDENT SPECIALISTS

IVC Student Success Team Roles

- STUDENT SPECIALISTS

 Starfish Flags Triage Flags and link students to other team members within team.
 Provide assistance to students to link them up to matriculation & core services , and basic needs.
 Contact students to confirm their learning and career program pathway.
 Work with IR to assess how many students have completed CSEPs
 Create a working roster of students that need CSEPs
 Set up appointments for students that need CSEP to meet with their SST Counselors.
 Provide SS program information to SST cohort for potential additional support services (i.e. IVC Kitchen, Tech support etc.).
 Check CANVAS and answer general questions or refer students to appropriate person/department

TEACHING FACULTY

- EBEGIN posting on CANVAS or (Email) to introduce themselves to SST students.
 Provide general information to the SST students on pathways, best practices, and career potential.
 Serve as a bridge to help students to contact their counselor through flags on STARFISH especially when students reach out for assistance.
 Work closely with counseling staff to ensure students are referred for services.

- COUNSELING FACULTY
 Meet with SST students to ensure they complete CSEP.

- Provide full counseling services (course advising/placement, petitions, transfer advising, etc.) to students within pathway.

 Work closely with faculty to assist students in planning their classes.


 Refer students to Student Success Specialist for assistance on how to navigate and access CANVAS, WEBSTAR, and STUDENT PORTAL.

 Provide referrals for tutoring.
- Enhance knowledge of pathway coursework, internships, and employment opportunities (may connect student to Career Education Services).
