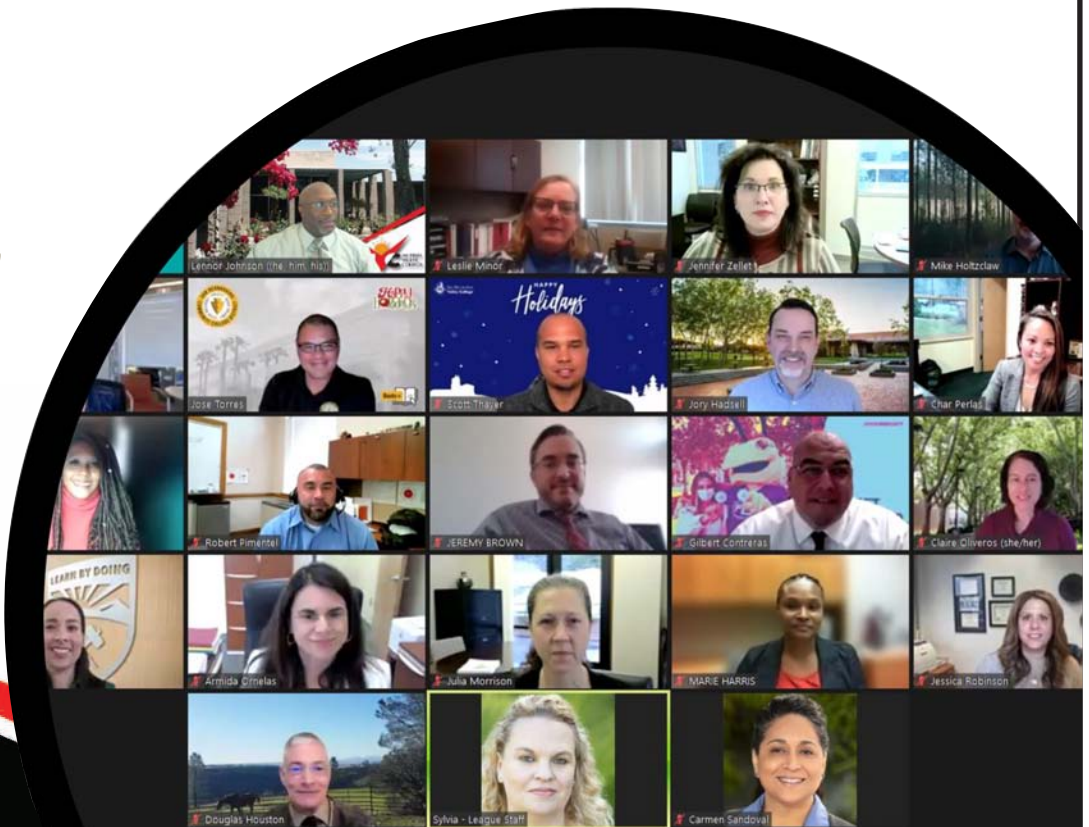

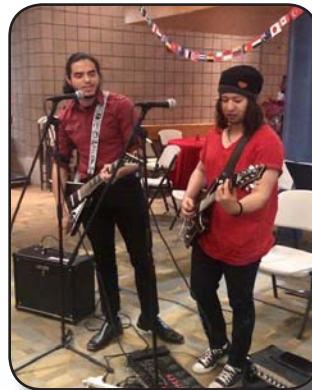
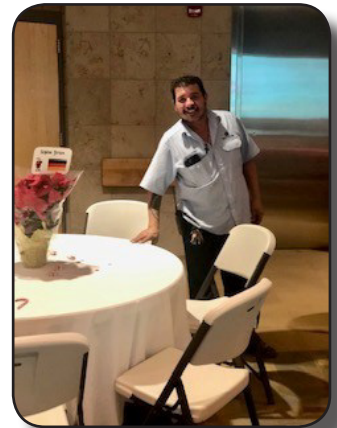

STATE UPDATE - 2 - YEAR BILLS

AB 75 O'Donnell Education finance: school facilities: Kindergarten-Community Colleges Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2022

- Authorizes \$12 billion in general obligation (GO) bonds for K-12 and California Community Colleges (CCC) school facilities construction and modernization projects to be placed on an unspecified statewide election in 2022.
- Location: Senate Education Committee

SB 22 GLAZER Education finance: school facilities: Public Preschool, K-12, and College Health and Safety Bond Act of 2022

- Authorizes \$15 billion for the construction and modernization of public preschool, K-12, community college, University of California (UC), and California State University (CSU) facilities to be placed on the ballot for statewide elections in 2022.
- Location: Assembly Education Committee

AB 421 Ward Community colleges: career development and college preparation courses

- Would allow the funding determination for career development and college preparation (CDCP) courses to be calculated based on either ongoing attendance counts or a census date count.
- Location: Senate Inactive File

AB 1432 Low The California Online Community College

- Would make the California Online Community College (also known as Calbright College) inoperative at the end of the 2022-23 academic year, and, as of January 1, 2024, repeals it.
- Location: Senate Education Committee

STATE UPDATE - 2 - YEAR BILLS

SB 205 Leyva School and community college employees: absences due to illness or accident

- This bill repeals existing laws requiring public and community college employees to pay for the cost of their substitutes while out on extended illness leave.
- Location: Senate Inactive File

AB 103 Holden College and Career Access Pathways partnerships: county offices of education

- Authorizes county offices of education (COE) to enter into College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) partnerships with the governing board of California Community College (CCC) districts and deletes the sunset date to provide the indefinite continuation of CCAP partnerships.
- Location: Assembly Higher Education Committee

AB 737 Santiago California State University: tuition

- Prohibits the charging of tuition or mandatory systemwide fees for enrollment at a campus of the California State University for any academic year, for up to 2 academic years, to a California Community College resident transfer student who has completed an associate degree for transfer, has received a fee waiver pursuant to the California College Promise.
- Location: Assembly Higher Education Committee
