# **STUDENT SERVICES**

### **SEA-Restorative Justice Program**

- The Restorative Justice Program department (Jovan Rodriguez, Rafael Montano, & Jennifer Jaime) along with Sociology Instructor Jim Shinn and Art Instructor Araceli Mangione attended the Basecamp Prison Education Summit at Tehachapi Mountain Park from June 8th June 12th.
- The summit consisted of administrators and faculty providing education in the incarceration system nationwide; where individuals shared their best practices, stories and mentorship.







Student Equity and Achievement hosted a Foster Youth Awareness Summit on May 19th. The summit provided information on services for foster youth students at IVC.

## STATE UPDATES ON PRIORITY LEGISLATION

- **AB 99 (Irwin):** This bill was gutted and amended from a Cradle to Career Data bill to a K-12 school safety bill. We will no longer track it.
- **AB 295 (Jones Sawyer):** This bill was amended to replace the term "enrollment" with "attendance".
- **AB 595 (Medina)**: This bill was amended to remove provisions requiring CSU and UC to commission a 3rd party study of any new student eligibility requirements. It also was amended to clarify the definition of "new eligibility requirement".
- **AB 1913 (Bryan):** This bill was amended to require LACCD to submit the required report to certain legislative committees and the Chancellor's Office.

### STATE UPDATES ON PRIORITY LEGISLATION

- AB 2617 (Holden): This bill was amended to specify that grants are for new or existing
  middle college or early college high schools or College and Career Access Pathways
  partnerships and require grantees that have a College and Career Access Pathways
  partnerships to do outreach that targets families and pupils who may not be college
  bound or who are underrepresented in higher education.
- AB 2937 (Higher Education Committee): This bill was amended to remove reference to community college being authorized to award baccalaureate degrees.
- **SB 20 (Dodd):** This bill was amended to remove provisions that require Chancellor's Office to develop a form for CalFresh eligibility. It also was amended to require CSAC to notify students of CalFresh eligibility "to extent permitted by federal law".
- **SB 964 (Wiener):** This bill was amended to establish the Future of California's Workforce and Surge in Behavioral Health Program to be administered by the Department of Health Care Access and Information. This program would establish priorities for growing the behavioral workforce. This bill would also establish the Behavioral Health Education Partnership.


#### IMPERIAL VALLEY **REGIONAL** CHAMBER of COMMERCE
