STATE UPDATE

- <u>AB 252 (Holden)</u> Amended to place the College Athlete Protection Program in the Office of Planning and Research instead of Department of Education.
- **AB 1575 (Irwin)** Requires the segments of postsecondary education to, upon enrollment, notify a student regarding the student's ability to select a designated advocate.
- <u>AB 359 (Holden)</u> Amended to require CDE to contract with a school district or COE instead of both and to require the districts that receive the technical assistance contract to report on use of funds to CCCCO, CDE and Dept of Finance.
- <u>AB 1096 (M. Fong)</u> Amendment to authorize a community college to offer courses taught in languages other than English without requiring students who enroll in those courses to concurrently enroll in an English as a Second Language (ESL) course.
- <u>AB 395 (Reyes)</u> This bill, on or before August 1, 2024, and on or before August 1st of every even-numbered year thereafter, would require each community college to develop an educational plan to provide a detailed sequence of courses, offered by the community college and ensure the community college offers the courses required in a consistent manner to ensure a clear academic plan.
- <u>AB 1138 (Weber)</u> As a condition of receiving state funds for student financial assistance, this bill would require the Trustees of the California State University, the Regents of the University of California, and the governing boards of independent postsecondary institutions to provide to students free of charge and, to the extent possible, in a manner that protects student anonymity, transportation to and from a rape crisis center to administer the Sexual Assault Forensic Examination (SAFE) Kit.
- <u>AB 1062 (Santiago)</u> This bill would prohibit the charging of tuition or mandatory systemwide fees for enrollment at a campus of the California State University for any academic year, for up to 2 academic years, to a California Community College resident transfer student who has completed an associate degree for transfer and demonstrates financial need.
